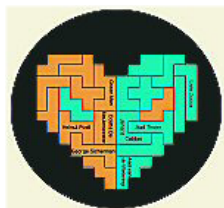


... The 2012 GAPE Award: "Yin-Yang Pentominoes" -----

Each year Kadon presents a prize, the Gamepuzzles Annual Pentomino Excellence award, for the best new pentomino idea of the year. However, the award for 2012 was three years in the making and was produced and presented in 2015. The winner was an international team of 8 puzzlists and their Yin-Yang Pentominoes project. Here is a quintessential solution of their idea, solved by Jenard Cabilao.



Congratulations to the collaborators: Jenard Cabilao, Green Man, Odette De Meulemeester, Helmut Postl, George Sicherman, Aad Thoen, Aad van de Wetering and Livio Zucca. The interactive award plaque was designed by Kate Jones, solved by Elijah Allen, and custom-made by Thomas Atkinson with the Kadon laser. 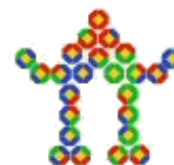

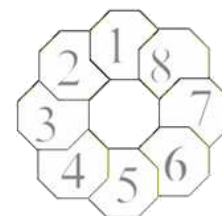
